# WELCOME TO OUR MONTHLY ROUND-UP SEPTEMBER EDITION

Throughout September, Human Appeal continued its unwavering mission to assist those in need. In Lebanon, we distributed essential food parcels to Syrian refugees, while in Morocco, we responded swiftly to earthquakes, providing emergency response kits. In Pakistan, we focused on enhancing livelihoods in Tharparkar, supplying families with milking goats and farmers with kitchen gardening tools, alongside hygiene awareness and equipment provisions in the Sindh region. In Palestine, we extended support through home repairs and olive tree planting. Somalia witnessed the installation of life-saving water kiosks, emergency nutrition interventions, and ongoing eye surgery campaigns, while Syria saw progress at Al Imaan Hospital, Al Yasameen village construction, and vital camp management efforts. In Yemen, we neared completion of one school project and initiated the renovation of another, ensuring continued access to education for local communities. In Nigeria, we're establishing sustainable water sources across three states and seven communities.

# LEBANON



## FOOD SECURITY



In Arsal, Lebanon, we provided essential food parcels to **268 Syrian refugee families**, each containing a well-balanced diet to enhance their resilience and overall health while alleviating economic burdens.

## REACH



Our committed team of **30 Reachers** made a substantial difference, touching the lives of **6,300 vulnerable individuals** in Lebanon within **four crucial areas**: Arsal, Saida, Shatila Camp in Beirut, and Qaroun. This support has also reached **50 orphans**. Their accomplishments include the preparation of **325 hot meals**, including **50** for orphans, the distribution of **550 food parcels**, **350 hygiene kits**, and **125 Back to School kits** to support children's education. They also distributed **550 gifts** to children and hosted an enjoyable family and orphan fun day.

# MOROCCO

In response to the September earthquakes in Morocco, we mobilised within **30 hours**, ultimately assisting **over 19,840 people** within the initial two weeks following the emergency.



## EMERGENCY



We delivered **967 food and hygiene kits** to families affected by the earthquake.



## EMERGENCY

As the winter season approaches, our focus turns to preparing the community for the challenging weather conditions. In our initial distribution, we will provide **500 waterproof tents**, with plans to increase this number in subsequent distributions. These tents are essential for offering families shelter, protecting them and their belongings from rain and cold.

Additionally, we are supplying warm clothing, such as boots and coats, to help individuals stay warm and dry as winter temperatures drop.

# PAKISTAN

## HEALTH



In partnership with UNICEF, Human Appeal Pakistan conducted **375 hygiene awareness sessions**, reaching students, teachers, and community members. Additionally, we distributed **300 Menstrual Hygiene Management Kits** and provided **18,323 bottles of handwashing soap** to empower women and girls in Dadu District and Qambar Shahdadkot, Sindh, Pakistan.

## LIVELIHOODS



Human Appeal has empowered **eight families** in Tharpakar by providing them with pairs of milking goats, offering valuable support to enhance their livelihoods. Furthermore, we organized a comprehensive one-day livestock management training program for the goat-receiving families, equipping them with essential knowledge on goat care.

# PALESTINE

## WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

## SHELTER



Human Appeal has begun a project to rehabilitate the houses of **27 widows** with children. This involves tiling, plastering or even rebuilding sections of the house.

## SHELTER



Amid the ongoing challenges in Gaza, Human Appeal remains committed to assisting affected families. We have extended our support to **80 families**, helping them with the essential tasks of repairing and maintaining their homes.

## LIVELIHOODS



In a bid to aid Palestinian farmers, Human Appeal distributed **30 olive trees** per dunum to residents of Wadi Gaza village. This initiative, benefiting approximately **278 individuals**, serves as compensation for the olive trees that have been tragically destroyed.

# SOMALIA



## WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)



In Somalia, our dedicated team has successfully installed **three water kiosks** within the Kahda displacement camps. This vital effort ensures access to safe and clean water for **600 families** and enhances security during night-time with the installation of solar lights.

## FOOD SECURITY

Our emergency nutrition intervention in Mogadishu has provided essential nutrition services, free of charge, to **1,606** severely malnourished children under-five and **10,906** pregnant and lactating women, encompassing both consultations and treatments.



## HEALTH



Our ongoing Eye Surgery Campaign in Somalia has entered its third phase, providing consultation and treatment to **720 patients** suffering from eye diseases or blindness, with **97** of them having received cataract surgery.

## EMERGENCY



Human Appeal's humanitarian efforts in Somalia extended to delivering water and food parcels to **1,500 households** in Galmdug state. Each household received a food parcel containing **55lbs** of rice, **55lbs** of wheat flour, **11lbs** of sugar, and **3 liters** of cooking oil. Additionally, each household received a **17-day** supply of **45 liters** of water, totaling 765 liters.

## CHILD WELFARE



We are proud to announce the registration of **308** new children in our orphan sponsorship program, opening doors for potential sponsorship by compassionate donors.

## HEALTH



Human Appeal established a crucial maternal healthcare facility in Kahda, Mogadishu, providing consultations and treatments to **1,085** pregnant and lactating women and **721 children** under the age of five. Additionally, **1,222 women** of childbearing age received health education and awareness sessions, while **986 individuals** received referrals to public hospitals.

## EMERGENCY



In the Gedo region of Somalia, we made a significant impact by distributing food parcels and water to vulnerable families. Each family received a food parcel consisting of **55lbs** of rice, **55lbs** of flour, **22lbs** of sugar, powdered milk, and **3 liters** of cooking oil, accompanied by a supply of **45 liters** of water.

# SYRIA



## HEALTH

In Sarmada, Human Appeal's Al Imaan Hospital remains steadfast in providing essential gynecological and pediatric care, free of charge, to numerous displaced and local Syrians in the region.

## SHELTER

Progress is underway at Al Yasameen in northwest Syria, where Human Appeal is diligently constructing **250 housing units**, equivalent to **1,000 homes**, to offer safe and secure shelter for displaced Syrians.

Human Appeal has received **ten medical containers** from Globus Relief, which will be meticulously organized, sorted, and distributed to healthcare facilities across northwest Syria. These containers will benefit hospitals, healthcare centers, physiotherapy facilities, dialysis centers, and post-hospital care centers.

## LIVELIHOODS

As an integral part of our camp management project, we are equipping residents of Al Zohoor with specialized training on fire prevention, the effective use of fire extinguishers, risk reduction, and fire response strategies.

## CHILD WELFARE



Human Appeal played a vital role in assisting Mustafa, a Syrian child who suffered severe burns at the tender age of **two months**. Through our support, he has undergone surgery to alleviate the effects of his burns, resulting in significant improvements in his health and relationships with his peers.


# YEMEN
